ABUSIVE CALLS TO 911 / BURGLARY OF HABITATION

TUESDAY JULY 9, 2013



On Monday July 9, 2013, at 10:36 pm, San Benito Police responded to a residence located on the 100 Block of Rosita Street in reference to a male subject who had called 911 advising the operator that he was armed with a handgun, and was going to use it on someone. Police Officers responded immediately, and approached the residence using caution making contact with 48 year old Daniel Romero Jr. out of San Benito, and who was highly intoxicated with an alcoholic beverage. The subject advised the Officers that he had called 911 saying that he had a gun because he wanted the Officers to respond immediately due to two females arguing at his residence. Daniel Romero stated that he did not have a gun, and no weapon was found on the subject. Daniel Romero Jr. was placed under for making abusive calls to 911 service. A local check revealed that the suspect had numerous outstanding municipal court warrants totaling \$ 1,550. Daniel Romero Jr. was then taken to City Jail where he was arraigned by Municipal Judge Ben Yudesis who set bond at \$8,000.

On Tuesday July 9, 2013, at 02:41 am, San Benito Police responded to the Stripes Store located on the 300 block of South Sam Houston Boulevard in reference to a male subject allegedly offering narcotics to customers outside the store. When an Officer arrived he made contact with 45 year old Jose Luis Lora out of San Benito. When the Police Officer was conducting a pat down for weapons or contraband the subject ran from the Officer thru an alley behind the store, but was caught a few moments later. It should be noted that the subject resisted arrest by not allowing the Officers to place hand restraints on him. Jose Luis Lora was placed under arrest, and while being searched a small amount of marijuana was found inside the suspect's right front pant pocket. Suspect was taken to City Jail where he was arraigned by Municipal Judge Ben Yudesis on charges for resisting arrest, evading arrest on foot, and possession of marijuana and bonds were set at \$14,000.
