ASSAULT CLASS A FAMILY VIOLENCE

THURSDAY MARCH 14, 2013



On Thursday March 14, 2013, at 06:13 am. San Benito Police received an emergency call regarding a domestic disturbance between husband and wife inside a red two door vehicle that was traveling south on Oscar Williams road. San Benito police located the vehicle, and proceeded to conduct a traffic stop by the Stripes store located on the intersection of Williams and Frontage road. The Officers then made contact with the male driver as well as two passengers who were identified as 29 year old Jesus Saldivar out of San Benito, and his 29 year old wife. The Police Officers then recognized the couple from a previous call regarding family violence that took place at 4:12 am in an apartment located on the 100 Block of South Bowie Street. According to the reporting Officer from that call he talked to the suspect as well as to the wife, but no one claimed that they had been the victims of any type of family violence. The 20 year old wife then began telling the Officers that after they left from the first call the suspect began assaulting her with his hands, and at point choked her. Female victim claims that she left the house on foot with their infant son after the assault when all of a sudden a red car with her husband, and another male subject who was driving approached her, and ordered her inside the car. According to the female victim she and her husband continued arguing inside the car and after a while the suspect began to physically assault her, and at one point bit her on her left leg. The male drivers of the vehicle witnessed the assault, and at one point advise the suspect to stop the assault. Jesus Saldivar was then placed under arrest, and transported to City Jail where he was booked on two counts of Assault class A family violence as well as Assault family violence impeding breathing 3rd degree Felony. Suspect was arraigned on the charges by Municipal Judge Ben Yudesis who set bond at \$35,000.
