## **PRESS RELEASE**

### **CRIMINAL TRESPASS / DWI**

**THURSDAY JANUARY 10, 2013**



On Wednesday January 9, 2013, at 3:49 pm, San Benito Police Officers responded to the Capital One bank located on the 100 Block of S. Sam Houston in reference to an unwanted male subject. Upon the Officers arrival they made contact with the branch manager who stated that the subject had left the bank, and was apparently harassing female employees at location. As the Officers were taking the report a second call was received at the SBPD communications center advising of an unwanted male subject creating a disturbance at a moving company located on the 100 Block of S. Bowie St. When the Officers arrived they discovered that it was the same subject from the previous call, and observed the male subject leaving the business. The Officers then made contact with the male subject who was identified as 49 year old Santiago "Jimmy" Lopez out of San Benito who presented signs of intoxication due to alcohol consumption, and was placed under arrest for Public Intoxication for his safety as well as the public. The moving company manager also filed criminal charges against Santiago Lopez for criminal trespass, and the suspect was taken to City Jail where he was booked in accordingly. Suspect was arraigned by Justice of the Peace Manuel Flores who set bond at \$3,000.

On Thursday January 10, 2013, at 04:19 am, A San Benito Patrol Officer observed a 2000 Blue Ford Explorer conduct a moving violation over by the 500 Block of East Stenger St. and initiated a traffic stop. The Police Officer then made contact with the driver who was identified as 42 year old Roberto Juan Leos out of Brownsville, and who showed signs of impairment due to alcohol consumption. The driver agreed to take a field sobriety test, and the Police Officer determined that the driver was in no condition to operate a motor vehicle. Driver was placed under arrest on suspicion of DWI and taken to City jail where upon arrival a breath test indicated that his Blood Alcohol Concentration was over the legal limit. Roberto Juan Leos was arraigned by Justice of the Peace Manuel Flores who set bond at \$5,000.
