PRESS RELEASE

AGGRAVATED ASSAULT / EVADING ARREST OR DETENTION

MONDAY NOVEMBER 12, 2012



On Saturday November 10, 2012, at 11:57 PM, San Benito Police responded to a residence located on the 800 Block of Arlington Street in reference to a domestic disturbance. Upon arrival the Officer made contact with a female by the main door of the residence advising the Officers to hurry up because a male family member was trying to stab another one inside the house. The Officers then discovered a 15 year old male juvenile trying to restrain 61 year old male identified as Carlos Monreal. The Officers then separated both individuals, and thru the course of the investigation it was revealed that Carlos Monreal had assaulted his 31 year old daughter by pushing and punching her with a closed fist on her head after a verbal altercation over domestic issues. At that point her 15 year old son intervened in order to protect his mother, and defend her from his grandfather. During the confrontation with his grandson Carlos Monreal produced a pocket knife, and apparently attempted to cut his grandson but he failed. Carlos Monreal was then placed under arrest, and charged with Aggravated Assault and Assault Class A family violence. Suspect was then transported to city Jail where he was arraigned by Municipal Judge David Garza who set bonds totaling \$10,000. An emergency protective order was filed against the suspect who was then transported to the Cameron County Jail.

On Saturday November 10, 2012, at 7:43 PM, San Benito Police responded to a residence located on the 1700 block of West Expressway 83 in reference to an 18 year old male highly intoxicated, and had broken a window to a residence. When the Officers arrived they made contact with 18 year old Adan C. Flores out of San Benito who appeared to be intoxicated. When the Police Officer attempted to place him under arrest the subject ran barefoot thru a grassy area, and tried to evade the Officers by jumping into an irrigation canal. The Officers were able to apprehend the subject once he made it across the ditch. The suspect was then taken to City Jail where he was arraigned on Charges of Evading arrest or detention, Criminal Mischief and public intoxication. Adan Flores was arraigned by Municipal Judge David Garza who set bonds at \$6,000.
