BURGLARY OF HABITATION / DWI CLASS A

TUESDAY SEPTEMBER 18, 2012



On Monday September 17, 2012, at 2:08 PM. San Benito Police Officers proceeded to execute a warrant of arrest issued by Justice Court for Antonio De Jesus Sanchez who was wanted in connection with a Burglary to Habitation that occurred on September 7, 2012 at a mobile home located on the 300 Block of South Williams Road. Antonio De Jesus Sanchez was accused by the 62 year old male victim of breaking into his home while he was asleep and assaulting him in the process. According to the victim, he struggled with his alleged assailant, and managed to escape his residence in order to seek help. The victim was taken to the hospital in order to be treated for his injuries. San Benito Police Detectives managed to get some leads on the alleged suspect who was positively identified by the Victim. Antonio De Jesus Sanchez was taken into custody at the San Benito High School and taken to City Jail. Antonio De Jesus Sanchez was arraigned by Justice of the Peace David Garza who set bond at \$10,000.

On Tuesday September 18, 2012, at 01:16 AM San Benito Police responded to the intersection of Frontage road and South Sam Houston in reference to a male subject asleep inside a Brown 1996 Ford F-150 Pick Up truck. When the Police Officer arrived, he discovered that the vehicle was on the frontage road parked against the traffic with a male subject asleep on the driver seat, engine running, and who was later identified as 35 year old Samuel Ayala out of Brownsville. Once the subject managed to wake the driver, he noticed signs of impairment due to alcohol consumption. The Police officers then conducted a Standardized Field Sobriety test and determined that Samuel Ayala was in no condition to be operating a motor vehicle. The driver was then taken to the San Benito Police Department where a breath test indicted that he was over the legal limit. Samuel Ayala was then charged with DWI-class A and arraigned by Municipal Judge David Garza who issued a \$2,000 personal recognizance bond.
