

PRESS RELEASE

ASSAULT FAMILY VIOLENCE / RESISTING ARREST

WEDNESDAY NOVEMBER 6, 2013



On Monday November 4th, 2013, at 10:33 PM. San Benito Police responded to a domestic disturbance taking place by the 300 block of South Sam Houston Boulevard between a male and a female. According to the eyewitnesses the male subject was assaulting the female, and police units responded immediately. When the Police Officers arrived the witness advised the officers that the couple had left in maroon in color BMW 4door. The responding units were able to locate the maroon BMW by a nearby alleyway where a Police Officer conducted a traffic stop, and made contact with the occupants of the vehicle. The male driver was identified as 29 year old Dave Anderson, and his common law wife identified as 23 year old Meytha Aguilar both out of San Benito. During the course of the investigation the Police Officers discovered that Dave Anderson had an outstanding traffic warrant from Municipal Court, and as he was placed under arrest Meytha Aguilar interfered with the arrest by attempting to take Dave Anderson away from the arresting officers, and getting in between the officers and the prisoner. The Police Officers then attempted to place Meytha Aguilar under arrest, but she became combative and resisted arrest. Once Meytha Aguilar was placed inside a Police Unit she kicked the rear passenger window out damaging the frame, and the door. The investigation also revealed that Dave Anderson had assaulted his common law wife, and was also charged with the offense of Assault Family Violence. Both Dave Anderson and Meytha Aguilar were taken to City Jail where they were booked in accordingly. Dave Anderson was arraigned on the charge of Assault Class A family violence by Judge David Garza who set bond at \$4,000. Meytha Aguilar was charged with the Offense of interfering with public duties, resisting arrest, criminal mischief class B misdemeanor, and was arraigned by Judge David Garza who set bonds totaling \$9,000.
