DRIVING WHILE INTOXICATED

Ynosencio Vega Jr.

On Saturday September 14, 2013 at 07:41pm a Patrol Officer conducted a traffic stop on a tan pickup at the 100 block of FM 732 for failing to maintain in a single marked lane. The Officer made contact with the driver who was identified as 63 year old Ynosencio Vega Jr. The Officer notice an odor of alcohol coming from Vega and Vega having slurred speech and red bloodshot eyes. Vega was asked if he had consumed alcohol and Vega stated he had one beer. Vega was asked to step out of the vehicle to perform the Standardized Field Sobriety Test. As he exited the vehicle Vega had difficulty maintaining his balance and walking to the rear of the vehicle. During the test Vega showed several signs of being intoxicated and failed the sobriety test. He was placed under arrest for Driving While Intoxicated and transported to the station. At the station Vega provided a sample of his breath with BAC results over 0.15 which enhanced the charge to a Class A Misdemeanor. He was arraigned by Justice of the Peace Judge David Garza and given a \$1,000 dollar Personal Recognizance Bond.

Lesley Dayan Corletto

On Sunday September 15, 2013 at 05:22am a Patrol Officer was called to Expressway 83 northbound in reference to a vehicle that possible needed assistance. As the Officer arrived he noticed that the vehicle had actually impacted the off ramp barrier and was not operational. He made contact with the driver of the vehicle who was identified as 23 year old Lesley Dayan Corletto who stated she fell asleep at the wheel. The Officer noticed a smell of alcohol coming from Corletto's breath and asked if she had been drinking. She stated she had but her last drink was at midnight. The Officer conducted the field sobriety test on Corletto but was unable to complete the test due to her being in shock of the accident. She was given an opportunity to give a sample of her breath to which she agreed. Corletto's results showed her to be over the legal limit of 0.08 and was placed under arrest for Driving While Intoxicated a Class B Misdemeanor. She was arraigned by Justice of the Peace Judge David Garza and given a \$1,000 dollar Personal Recognizance Bond.

Raul Martinez

On Sunday September 15, 2013 at 01:20am a Patrol Officer conduct a traffic stop on the 800 block of N. Dick Dowling on a Black Dodge pickup for speeding. The Officer made contact with the driver who was identified as 35 year old Raul Martinez. Martinez was advised the reason for the stop and he blamed the reason for his speed on the air condition in his vehicle. The Officer could smell a strong odor of alcohol coming from Martinez and asked if he had been drinking. Martinez stated he had two beers and was asked to perform the Standardized Field Sobriety Test. Martinez was asked to step out of the vehicle and during the instructional part of the test Martinez would hold on the vehicle for balance. Martinez performed the test poorly and was placed under arrest for Driving While Intoxicated and transported to the city jail. He was arraigned by Justice of the Peace Judge David Garza and given a \$1,000 dollar Personal Recognizance Bond.
