DRIVING WHILE INTOXICATED 2ND OFFENSE, THEFT

On Monday August 26, 2013 at 11:56pm a Patrol Officer noticed a dark in color GMC pickup truck traveling at a high rate of speed on the 200 block of E. Robertson. The Officer conducted a traffic stop on the vehicle and made contact with the driver who was identified as 21 year old Javier Rios. The Officer observed two alcoholic beverage containers in the center console and asked the driver to step out of the vehicle. During the interview with Rios, the Officer could smell an odor of alcohol coming from his breath. Rios was asked to conduct a series of field sobriety test to which he agreed. Rios failed all test and was placed under arrest for driving while intoxication. A criminal history check revealed Rios had prior DWI arrest which enhanced the charge to Driving While Intoxicated 2nd Offense a Class A Misdemeanor. He was placed in jail and was later arraigned by Justice of the Peace Judge David Garza and bond was set at \$5,000 dollars.

On Monday August 26, 2013 at 04:20pm Patrol Officers were called to the EZ Pawn located at 100 S. Sam Houston in reference to a theft. When Officers arrived a male stated he left his

wallet on the front counter and when he returned a short time later his wallet was placed on the opposite side of the counter and \$53.00 dollars was taken. Video surveillance showed a male wearing a white shirt, a rosary around his neck and a black ball cap grab the wallet, open it and take the money. At 06:27pm a call to dispatch came in advising the male who possibly took the money was traveling north on Sam Houston Blvd in a silver vehicle. The Officer located the vehicle and conducted a traffic stop. The male got off the vehicle and walked to the officer admitting he took the money from the wallet at EZ Pawn. The male was identified as 24 year old Broderick Dewayne McDaniel Jr. McDaniel was placed under arrest for theft and the money was returned to the owner. McDaniel was transported to the city jail where he was later arraigned by Justice of the Peace Judge David Garza and given a \$1,000 dollar personal recognizance bond.
