## **PRESS RELEASE**

### **DWI 3<sup>rd</sup> / FELONY THEFT**

**WEDNESDAY JANUARY 7<sup>TH</sup>, 2015**



**ERIC YZAGUIRRE:** On Wednesday January 7<sup>th</sup>, 2015, at 02:00 am A San Benito Patrol officer observed a White VW Jetta traveling south on McCoulough Street, and failed to stop at several intersections. The Police Officer then initiated a traffic stop on the white Jetta, and was pulled over by the 400 Block of S. Bonham. The Police Officer then made contact with the driver who was identified as 30 year old Eric Yzaguirre out of San Benito. The Police Officer then detected signs of impairment due to possible alcohol consumption, and the driver agreed in taking a field sobriety test. The Police Officer then determined that the driver was impaired, and could not be operating a motor vehicle. Eric Yzaguirre was then placed under arrest for Driving While Intoxicated, and a criminal records check revealed that the driver had several prior DWI convictions, and a blood search warrant was obtained. Driver was then taken to a local hospital for a blood withdrawal. Suspect was arraigned by Municipal Judge Ben Yudesis who set bond at \$20,000.

**JOSHUA KELLY URANGA:** On Tuesday January 6<sup>th</sup>, 2015, at 5:30 pm. San Benito Police Officers responded to the Wal-Mart supercenter located on the 1100 block of West Business 77 in reference to a theft in progress. When the Officer arrived at location they made contact with loss prevention who then advised the officers that a male subject had just purchased 3 items worth over \$500, secured the items inside his tan 1994 Buick 4 door, and returned inside the only to grab 3 similar items and try to obtain a refund. The male subject after completing the transaction walked to his vehicle but was stopped by the Police Officers who detained the suspect who was identified as 34 year old Joshua Uranga who provided an address from out of State. The suspect was then placed under arrest for Theft after the items he had initially bought were located in the backseat of his Buick. Criminal Records check reveal that the suspect had 2 prior theft convictions enhancing the current offense to a State Jail Felony. Suspect was taken to City Jail where he was arraigned by Municipal Judge Ben Yudesis who set bond at \$15,000.
