## **PRESS RELEASE**

### **POSSESSION OF CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE**

MONDAY JUNE 1<sup>ST</sup>, 2015



**CYNTHIA YADIRA VILLARREAL-GAMEZ:** On 05/30/2015 at 2:47 a.m., A San Benito Police Officer conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle over by the 100 block of South Sam Houston for a traffic violation. The Police Officer made contact with the driver and who was accompanied by 31 year old passenger Cynthia Yadira Villarreal-Gamez . The driver was suspected of DWI, and was placed under arrest. Cynthia Villarreal Gamez was also placed under arrest for Public Intoxication. A search Ms. Gamezs' pant pockets produced a small clear plastic baggie that contained a small amount of cocaine. Both females were transported to City Jail. Cynthia Yadira Villarreal-Gamez was arraigned on the charges of Public Intoxication and Possession of a Control Substance by Municipal Judge Ben Yudesis who set bond at \$5,000. HSI agents placed an immigration detainer on her.

**DAVID DE LEON:** 05/31/2015 at 5:36 a.m., a San Benito Police Officer conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle over by the 600 block of Wentz Street for a traffic violation. The Police Officer conducting the stop removed the driver in order to conduct a field sobriety test. Another San Benito Police Officer who arrived to assist the initial officer then made contact with the male passenger who was identified as 34 year old David De Leon out of Mercedes. The Police Officer observed that David DeLeon had concealed a small plastic baggie under the carpet of the passenger seat. The subject was detained, and when the Officer searched the vehicle, he located two clear plastic baggies that contained a rock like substance that later tested positive for crack cocaine. The passenger was then charged with Possession of controlled substance PG-1 in a drug free zone due to being found less than 1000 feet from an elementary. Suspect was arraigned by Municipal Judge Ben Yudesis who set bond at \$15,000.
