POSS. OF CRACK COCAINE/ASSAULT IMPEDING BREATH

TUESDAY JULY 21ST, 2015



GERMAN ZUNIGA: On Monday July 20th, 2015 at 10:40 a.m., San Benito Police Detectives arrived at a trailer park located on the 1500 Block of Combes Street in reference to a lead regarding stolen property being stored at location. The Investigators upon arrival made contact with 2 male subjects outside the residence who began providing the investigators with conflicting stories regarding their presence at location The Police Investigators then proceeded to detain the subjects until they determine what exactly they were doing at location. One of the subjects was identified as 25 year old German Zuniga out of San Benito. When a police detective searched German Zuniga for weapons the subject admitted that he was in possession of marijuana. The officer retrieved several baggies that contained marijuana from the subjects pockets as well as a several other baggies that contained crack cocaine. German Zuniga was placed under arrest and taken to City Jail where he was arraigned on charges of Possession of Controlled substance (cocaine) 2nd degree felony as well as possession of marijuana class A misdemeanor all in drug free zone by Municipal Judge Ben Yudesis who set bonds totaling \$30,000. Suspect had an active warrant from the Cameron County Sheriff's Department for failure to appear, and was transported to the Cameron County Jail.

LORENZO CARLOS GONZALEZ: On Sunday July 19th, 2015, at 9:40 pm. San Benito Police Officers arrived at an apartment complex located on the 1100 block of South McCullough where they made contact with 22 year old Lorenzo Carlos Gonzalez out of San Benito, and who had an active warrant issued by Municipal Court for the Offense of Assault Family Violence Impeding breath/circulation 3rd degree Felony. Lorenzo Carlos Gonzalez was wanted in connection to a Police report filed by his 21 year common law wife alleging that on 07/01/2015 during the evening hours the suspect who was under the influence of alcohol had assaulted her numerous times, and twice had placed his hands around her neck causing her to go unconscious for several moments. Lorenzo Gonzalez was placed under arrest and taken to City Jail where he was later arraigned by Municipal Judge Ben Yudesis who set bond at \$25,000 as well as issuing a protective order against the suspect.
