

## **PRESS RELEASE**

### **BURGLARY OF HABITATION/DWI 3<sup>RD</sup> OR MORE**

**MONDAY AUGUST 10<sup>TH</sup>, 2015**



**LUIS GALVAN:** On Friday August 7<sup>th</sup>, 2015, San Benito Police Officers responded to a residence located on the 1700 Block of Combes Street in reference to a wanted subject at location. When the Police Officers arrived they made contact with 48 year old Luis Galvan out of San Benito who had an active warrant of arrest for the Offense of Burglary of Habitation (2<sup>nd</sup> degree Felony) issued from Municipal Court. Luis Galvan was wanted in connection to a burglary that occurred on July 26, 2015 during the nighttime hours after he allegedly broke into a residence also on the 1700 block of Combes, but a female that was inside the residence at the time of the incident managed to identify the suspect. Luis Galvan was placed under arrest and taken to City Jail where he was arraigned by Municipal Judge Ben Yudesis who set bond at \$10,000.

**ERIC IZAGUIRRE:** On Saturday August 8<sup>th</sup>, 2015, at 6:00 am. San Benito Police Officers responded to a possible domestic disturbance between husband and wife over at a residence located on the 400 block of Elvira Street. According to the caller, the male subject was leaving the scene in a white VW Jetta. Responding Officers located the white Jetta traveling North of McCullough Street, and proceeded to pull the vehicle over by the Intersection of Adele and McCullough. The driver was identified as 30 year old Eric Izaguirre out of San Benito, who advised the Officers that he was in fact leaving the scene in order to avoid further problems with his wife. The Police Officers noticed that the driver presented signs of impairment due to alcohol consumption, and the driver agreed in taking a field sobriety test. Once the test was completed the Police Officers determined that the subject was in no condition to be operating a motor vehicle. The Officers requested a breath sample from the driver who refused the test. The Police Officers then obtained a blood warrant, and the subject was taken to a local hospital for a blood withdrawal. Eric Izaguirre was then taken to City Jail where he was charged with DWI 3<sup>rd</sup> or more after a record check revealed prior arrests for DWI. Suspect was arraigned by Municipal Judge Ben Yudesis who set bonds at \$15,000.
