

UNAUTHORIZED USE OF VEHICLE / ASSAULT FAMILY VIOLENCE

MONDAY NOVEMBER 2ND, 2015



ARTURO GARZA: On Thursday November 29, 2015, at 08:40 am 58 year old Arturo Garza turned himself in at the San Benito Police Department. Arturo Garza had an active warrant issued out by Municipal Court for the offense of Assault Family Violence-Impeding Breath or circulation which is a 3rd degree Felony. Suspect was wanted in connection to an incident that took place on October 21, 2015, at 10:30 pm at an apartment complex located on the 300 block of south Helen Moore Rd. The suspect was accused of being involved in an assault during an argument. Arturo Garza was placed under arrest and arraigned by Municipal Judge David Garza who issued a \$5,000 personal recognizance bond.

JESUS VIRGILIO: On Saturday October 31st, 2015, at 1:00 pm. San Benito Police responded to the 900 block of Chapman in reference to a possible medical emergency. Upon arrival the Officers made contact with an 18 year old male who stated that he had found a male subject inside his aunt's 1998 Green Jeep that was parked outside his residence, and the subject appeared to be having some sort of attack. The Police Officers then requested EMS at the scene, but soon they discovered that the subject was highly intoxicated with alcohol. The subject was identified as 53 year old Jesus Virgilio out of San Benito. The 18 year old male advised the officer that he was waiting for a mechanic to arrive to inspect the Jeep when he noticed Jesus Virgilio inside the Jeep. According to the victim, the suspect had turned the vehicle on and was revving the engine. EMS assistance was declined by the subject who was then placed under arrest for Burglary of a vehicle (Class A misdemeanor) and Unauthorized Use of Motor Vehicle (State Jail Felony). Jesus Virgilio was then taken to City Jail where he was arraigned by Municipal Judge David Garza who issued a \$10,000 personal recognizance bond. Suspect was later detained by HSI investigators due to having an Immigration detainer.
