PRESS RELEASE

SEXUAL ASSAULT / POSSESSION OF COCAINE

TUESDAY APRIL 29, 2014



On Saturday April 26, 2014, at 7:53 pm, a San Benito Police Officer observed a red Ford Taurus traveling by the 300 Block of East Stenger commit a traffic violation and proceeded to conduct a traffic stop on the vehicle. Contact was then made with the driver who was identified as Julio Cesar Coello. He appeared nervous at the time of the stop. Consent to search was obtained from the driver. During the search the Police Officer discovered two large clear plastic baggies inside the center console that contained 20 individually wrapped small baggies with a white powdery substance that later tested positive for cocaine. The Police Officer then attempted to place hand restraints on the driver, but Mr. Cuello began running south on Dowling Street. The police officer then gave chase, and caught the driver over by the 100 Block of South Dowling. The suspect continued to resist, but eventually was placed under arrest with the assistance of responding officers. Contraband and driver were then taken to the Police station for processing. Julio Coello was charged with possession of controlled substance, resisting arrest and evading arrest. Suspect was arraigned by Municipal Judge David Garza who set bonds totaling \$30,000.

On Monday April 27, 2014, at 11:00 pm. San Benito Police Officers responded to the B & M port of entry in Brownsville, Texas in reference to a subject detained by US Customs and Border Protection agents who had an outstanding warrant for his arrest for the offense of Sexual Assault. The Officers upon arrival made contact with CBP agents who then proceeded to release 42 year Onorio Ramos Arreola to the custody of San Benito Police. The suspect was wanted in connection to an alleged sexual assault that occurred in February 2006. In that incident his ex-wife claimed that she had been sexually assaulted by the alleged suspect, and after the incident the suspect fled to Mexico. On Monday Night the suspect attempted to enter the US thru the B&M Bridge but a criminal background check revealed that the subject was outstanding from this Department. Suspect was then taken to City Jail where he was arraigned by Municipal Judge Ben Yudesis who denied bond. Suspect was then taken to the Cameron County Jail where he currently remains with an Immigration Detainer.
