

## **PRESS RELEASE**

### **AGGRAVATED ASSAULT / INTOXICATION ASSAULT**

**MONDAY MAY 19, 2014**



#### **Eduardo Ramirez**

On Sunday May 18, 2014, at 10:15 pm. San Benito Police Responded to a domestic disturbance between husband and wife over by an apartment complex located on the 2000 block of East Stenger St. When the Police Officers arrived they made contact with a 41 year old female who stated that her 58 year old husband who she identified as Eduardo Ramirez had assaulted her with a broom stick, and stabbed her with a kitchen knife on her right thigh after a verbal altercation. The police officers located Eduardo Ramirez inside the apartment asleep, and proceeded to place him under arrest for aggravated assault with a deadly weapon. Suspect was taken to City Jail where he was arraigned by Municipal Judge David Garza who also served the suspect with an emergency protective order, and set bond at \$20,000.

#### **Jose Olmos Jr**

On Sunday May 18, 2014, at 10:26 pm San Benito Police responded to the intersection of Sherer Road and Pennsylvania Avenue in reference to a 2 vehicle collision with possible injuries. When the Police Officers arrived they observed a silver Ford Focus with considerable damage to the rear, and the occupants were complaining of injuries. The Police Officers also located an unoccupied black Chevrolet Tahoe also at the intersection with considerable damage to the front. According to the occupants of the Ford Focus the two male occupants of the Chevrolet Tahoe had fled the scene after rear ending their car. The Police Officers then proceeded to search the area, and after several minutes they located two male subjects hiding in a nearby canal. The subjects were then detained, and a preliminary investigation revealed that 38 year old Jose Olmos Jr of San Benito was driving the Tahoe at the time of the crash with the Focus. The Police Officers detected signs of impairment on the suspected driver due to alcohol consumption. The other subject that was with Jose Olmos Jr. was complaining of injuries that he sustained during the crash as well. Jose Olmos was then placed under arrest, and charged with 3 counts of intoxication assault. Suspect was taken to City Jail where a breath test indicated that his blood alcohol content at the time was above the legal limit of 0.800. Suspect was arraigned by Municipal Judge David Garza who set bonds totaling \$15,000. All 3 victims required hospitalization for minor injuries.
