EVADING ON VEHICLE/BURGLARY OF HABITATION

MONDAY OCTOBER 20, 2014



JESUS CASTILLO: On October 13, 2014 a Patrol Officer took a report of a burglary of a habitation on the 1800 block of La Palma. The home owner arrived home and noticed blood throughout her home and glass broken from her front door. The blood led to a home a couple of house away from her residence. A male who resides at the home was identified as 45 year old Jesus Castillo. Police noticed that Castillo had a laceration to his wrist and brought him to the police station for questioning. After investigating the case, a Police Detective gathered an arrest warrant for Burglary of a Habitation and Castillo was arrested on October 19, 2014. He was arraigned by Judge David Garza and bond was set at \$30,000 dollars.

ALFREDO GARZA: On Monday October 20, 2014, at 01:30 am A San Benito Police Officer out on patrol observed two vehicles racing by the intersection of Resaca Shores and Sam Houston traveling south on Sam Houston. The Police Officer then activated the emergency lights on his police cruiser, but one of the vehicles described as a grey 2008 Chevy Tahoe refused to stop, and instead accelerated leading the Police Officer on a pursuit thru a residential area. The vehicle finally stopped outside a residence located on the 1400 Block of South McCullough where the driver who was identified as 21 year old Alfredo Garza of San Benito resisted his arrest. Suspect was finally taken into custody, and transported to City Jail where he was booked on charges of evading on vehicle, resisting arrest, racing on a public highway. Suspect was arraigned by Municipal Judge David Garza who set bonds totaling \$35,000.
