Action Minutes for Traffic and Safety Board Meeting Held on Feb 21, 2024

Agenda Item #1- Welcome

Meeting was called to order by Captain Michael Cortez of the San Benito Police Department at approximately 5:30 pm. Traffic and Safety Board Members present were Place 1 Member Mr. Mario Cervantes, Place 3 Member Mr. Lawrence (Larry) Drake and Place 5 Member Mr. Jose Santos Vargas Jr. Noted not present were Mr. Adrian Gonzalez (Place 2) and Mr. Julian Rios (Place 4). Quorum was met and the meeting was proceeded with.

Agenda Item #2- Board Members Introductions / Comments / News

Each board member present along with Captain Cortez gave their respective introductions. There were no members of the general public in attendance at this meeting and therefore were no public comments to record.

Agenda Item #3- Dissemination of City of San Benito City Ordinance numbers 2525, 2356 and City of San Benito Resolution number 2012-6

Members of the Traffic and Safety board had been provided this information via an email sent prior to the meeting date for familiarity. Paper packets were also prepared by Captain Cortez and were presented to the members present for their keeping. Also included within this packet were the results of a speed study conducted on the 1600 Block of South Mcculloch Street from 6/14/2023 to 6/21/2023. Captain Cortez briefly went over the ordinances with the members and the results of the speed study were also examined.

Agenda Item #4- Review of Speed Hump Request Submitted on 2/7/2024 by Mr. Robert Perez for the 1500 to 30000 blocks of South Mcculloch Street

In review of the information contained within the traffic study conducted by the San Benito Police Department, all present members of the board requested and supported the implementation of speed humps to be placed along the requested blocks outlined in the request. The area of the request can be more generally described as South Mcculloch Street between Yost and Pennsylvania Streets.

(Note: The City of San Benito's extra-territorial jurisdiction ends at or near the residence of 1640 South Mcculloch Street)
